

Mr. Switzer's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Policy

✚ *What is BYOD?*

- Allows students to bring personal electronic devices to school for educational purposes.

✚ *What type of electronic devices are permitted?*

- Laptops, Ipads, Tablets, Ipad, SmartPhones, etc.

✚ *Who regulates the use of these devices?*

- The classroom teacher decides when and if students are allowed to use them.

(Bring Your Own Device)



✚ *Does this mean I can use my cell phone in class to do whatever I want?*

- No, the use of cell phones for any voice or text communication is **prohibited** during class, and must be used for educational purposes only.

✚ *What are the consequences for inappropriate use of electronic devices?*

- 1st Offense -- Warning
- 2nd Offense – Parent Contact & Teacher's Detention (before or after school)
- 3rd Offense – Parent Contact & Referral to administration
- 4th Offense – Referral to administration

✚ *Can I plug in and charge my electronic device in a classroom outlet?*

- No, electronic devices cannot be plugged in to charge in a classroom outlet. If devices need charging, a student can bring portable charging station for individual use.

✚ *Is Dorman responsible if I lose or damage my electronic device while at school?*

- No, Dorman is **NOT** responsible for lost or damaged electronic devices. Students should bring devices at their own risk.
