4 What is BYOD?

• Allows students to bring personal electronic devices to school for educational purposes.

What type of electronic devices are permitted?

• Laptops, Ipads, Tablets, Ipod, SmartPhones, etc.

Who regulates the use of these devices?

• The classroom teacher decides when and if students are allowed to use them.

B.Y.O.D. (Bring Your Own Device)



4 Does this mean I can use my cell phone in class to do whatever I want?

• No, the use of cell phones for any voice or text communication is **prohibited** during class, and must be used for educational purposes only.

What are the consequences for inappropriate use of electronic devices?

- 1st Offense -- Warning
- 2nd Offense Parent Contact & Teacher's Detention (before or after school)
- 3rd Offense Parent Contact & Referral to administration
- 4th Offense Referral to administration

4 Can I plug in and charge my electronic device in a classroom outlet?

• No, electronic devices cannot be plugged in to charge in a classroom outlet. If devices need charging, a student can bring portable charging station for individual use.

Is Dorman responsible if I lose or damage my electronic device while at school?

• No, Dorman is <u>NOT</u> responsible for lost or damaged electronic devices. Students should bring devices at their own risk.
