## Mr. Switzer's Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Policy

### **4** What is BYOD?

• Allows students to bring personal electronic devices to school for educational purposes.

## **What type of electronic devices are permitted?**

• Laptops, Ipads, Tablets, Ipod, SmartPhones, etc.

### **Who regulates the use of these devices?**

• The classroom teacher decides when and if students are allowed to use them.

## **4** Does this mean I can use my cell phone in class to do whatever I want?

• No, the use of cell phones for any voice or text communication is **prohibited** during class, and must be used for educational purposes only.

## **What are the consequences for inappropriate use of electronic devices?**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense -- Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense Parent Contact & Teacher's Detention (before or after school)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense Parent Contact & Referral to administration
- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense Referral to administration

## **4** Can I plug in and charge my electronic device in a classroom outlet?

• No, electronic devices cannot be plugged in to charge in a classroom outlet. If devices need charging, a student can bring portable charging station for individual use.

# Is Dorman responsible if I lose or damage my electronic device while at school?

• No, Dorman is <u>NOT</u> responsible for lost or damaged electronic devices. Students should bring devices at their own risk.
